CNA experts and members continually analyse Calypso's offering to robustly and elegantly evolve the standard to meet the ambitions of the global community.

By joining and participating in CNA's working groups, each member can influence the future direction of Calypso Specifications.

As a member-driven organisation, CNA facilitates collaboration through strategic and technical working groups. Members can openly discuss challenges, potential solutions and ultimately help refine the open Calypso Standard to suit the practical requirements of mobility stakeholders worldwide, long into the future.

CNA's working groups are aligned to key strategic priorities:

WG1

Improving and developing Calypso's reference specification to provide an appropriate solution to transport operator needs. WG1 incorporates dedicated Technical Committees focused on: Card; Terminals; Security; Interoperability; Mobile; and ABT.

WG2

Championing interoperability between and among transport networks, to ensure that any Calypso portable object can work with any Calypso terminal.

WG3

Promoting Calypso Standards worldwide and participating in national and international standardisation initiatives to encourage industry best practice.

WG4

Supporting the promotion of Calypso and its benefits through dedicated events, communications and marketing.




Exclusive access to Calypso technical documents
